



Dress Code

Appropriate attire for the dining room and bar is dress casual or golf attire during the day and dress casual in the evening. **No tee shirts or clothing that is faded, torn or with holes will be allowed.**

The Dining Room Manager has the discretion to determine whether attire is consistent with this policy. As a courtesy to all members, gentlemen are asked to **remove their hats in the dining room**, however **hats are allowed to be worn on the deck and in the bar area only.**

On the golf course, men are required to wear collared shirts or turtlenecks. Specifically excluded on the golf course are denim, cutoffs, athletic or short shorts, tank tops and tee shirts.

Swimming attire is allowed only at the pool and appropriate attire, including shoes, must be worn when exiting the pool area.

This policy will be strictly enforced, and all members are asked to please communicate the dress code to their guests when entertaining at the Club to avoid any embarrassing situations.
